

GAME SUGGESTIONS




Ticket to Ride is a cross country train adventure in which players collect and play matching train cards to claim railway routes connecting cities throughout North America. - Sammi

Shoutrageous - You can play this game 1-on-1 or in teams. Players have categories and the goal is to name as many items in that category that you can think of - Colby


GAME SUGGESTIONS



This game could be played with a deck of cards or on one of the many free Gin Rummy apps. Also, try the similar tile game Rummikub - Carole




Try either the board game version of this classic game or the app, Words With Friends, that allows you to play against your friends. - Carole




Mexican Train Dominoes - Carole

GAME SUGGESTIONS




Great for families and children, Dixit incorporates interesting artwork and requires some creativity - Crystal N.



Yahtzee is a classic game played with dice. Play this as a board game or on the Yahtzee app - Dennis




This game is both fun and easy! LCR (Left Right Center) is a great game for many people - Kathy
