In a printed or typed essay of 500 words or less explain how you meet one or more of the above 3 requirements *and* how you have used your leadership skills to impact positive change in your community. *Also explain* how you will use your education to promote a more welcoming and accessible community for people of all abilities. Along with your essay *please include* one personal letter of recommendation.
